Westminster sweet for Candy deal

The Candy brothers are to convert a Westminster office block, SW1, into 31 luxury flats.

Westminster city council has resolved to grant planning permission for CPC Group's proposal to redevelop the block at 26 Chapter Street, SW1.

The property was bought by CPC in 2008 and is let to the Chartered Institute of Management Accountants, on a 15-year lease which expires in September 2015.

The Waugh Thistleton Architects-designed scheme proposes the fourth storey be demolished and replaced with a new double-level top floor.
