British companies networked with prospective overseas clients in this temporary timber pavilion in the grounds of Lancaster House this summer. Seventeen sector-themed events made up the British Business Embassy programme, which took place during the Olympics and Paralympics. The pavilion, designed by architect Waugh Thistleton, was built largely offsite by a team of specialist joiners at Insulshell, part of Velodrome ceiling contractor Wood Newton. The project team was unable to highlight its work at the time due to security and marketing restrictions.
